

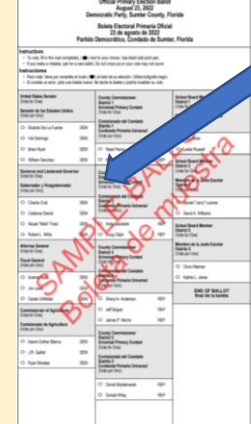
November Ballots will be Mailed October 6th

How to Vote By Mail

Mark your ballot with a black ballpoint pen

Put your ballot in the Sleeve

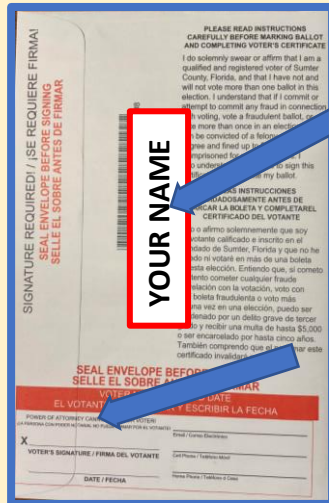
Put the Sleeve in YOUR RETURN ENVELOPE



Look for **YOUR NAME** under the **barcode** on YOUR RETURN ENVELOPE

Seal the envelope

Sign and Date at the bottom



Stamp and Mail it
